

Vaccinations at a glance

Disease	Name of travel vaccine	Schedule	Booster
Diphtheria, Tetanus, Polio vaccine (DTP)	REVAXIS	Single dose if vaccinated as a child. If never vaccinated 0, 1 and 2 months	10 years
Hepatitis A vaccine	AVAXIM / VAQTA / HAVRIX	1 dose	2nd dose 6 - 12 months later will give 20 years' immunity
Typhoid vaccine	TYPHIM Vi	Single dose	3 years
Hepatitis B vaccine	ENGERIX B / HBVaxPRO	0, 1, 6 months. Accelerated schedule 0, 7, 21 days	Single booster 5 years after primary immunisation for those at high risk
Rabies vaccine	RABIES BP / RABIPUR	0, 7, 21/28 days. Accelerated schedule 0, 3, 7 days	10 years
Cholera vaccine	DUKORAL	2 doses at 0 and 1-6 weeks	2 years
Meningitis ACWY vaccine	NIMENRIX	1 dose	5 years
Japanese encephalitis vaccine	IXIARO	0, 28 days. Accelerated schedule 0, 7 days	2 years
Hepatitis A/B combined travel vaccine	TWINRIX	0, 1, 6 months. Accelerated schedule 0, 7, 21 days	Booster of Hepatitis B 5 years. Booster of Hepatitis A at 6 - 12 months lasts 20 years.
Typhoid / Hepatitis A vaccine	VIATIM	Single dose	Booster of Hepatitis A 6 - 12 months Typhoid 3 years.
Tick borne encephalitis	TicoVac	3 doses 0, 1-3 months, 5-12 months	Booster every 3 years
Measles, mumps, Rubella (MMR)	MMRVaxPro	2 doses one month apart	
Yellow fever	STAMARIL	1 dose	Lifelong. Certificate valid for 10 years
Typhoid oral vaccine	VIVOTIF	Oral dose. 0, 2 and 4 days	3 years
